

TIPS FOR TAKING CARE OF YOUR MANAGED BYOD DEVICE

- Perform updates while at home, sometimes these can take a long time to install and require a restart.
- Charge the device each night so that it is ready to use at school the next day.
- iPads can bend, consider an “always on” case.
- Don’t eat or drink where food or liquid can fall and get inside your device.
- Explore third party insurance, sometimes home insurance can cover damage if the damage occurs while at home. Edunet also offers insurance. Warranty does not cover damage.
- Avoid using the device in bed or with blankets that can block the device vents and cause overheating.
- Get the most out of your device by having a dedicated place to use it that is free from clutter.
- Never carry your device while the screen is open.
- Securely store your device. Never leave it in an unsafe place (exposed in a car, on a classroom table, or any unsupervised area).
- Do not place anything near the device that could put pressure on the screen.
- Do not place anything in the carrying case that will press against the cover.
- Do not poke the screen.
- Do not place anything on the keyboard before closing the lid (e.g. pens, pencils, or books).
- Do not use abrasive materials or chemicals to clean screens. Clean the screen with a soft, dry cloth or anti-static cloth.
- Do not “bump” the device against lockers, walls, car doors, floors, etc., as it will easily damage the screen.
- Do not lean on the top of the device when it is closed.
- Consider purchasing a protective case. This case will have sufficient padding to protect the device from damage under normal treatment and use. It is intended to provide a safe and suitable means for carrying the device to and from home and also within the school premises. If you do have a case ensure that the device is always kept in its protective case when being carried. Some carry cases can hold other objects (such as folders and workbooks), but these must be kept to a minimum to avoid placing too much pressure and weight on the screen.
- Turn the device off before placing it in the carrying case to protect it from possible overheating and battery drain.
- Devices should be shut down before the end of session 2 and 4; this is intended to conserve battery life.
